Participants	Sunburn/heat stroke. Dehydration if weather is hot	H	All volunteers to be advised to wear sun cream and hats if very hot. Water to be on the float. Float has a roof.	L	
Bucket collectors	Could be knocked over by a lorry	M	All collectors to be advised to walk a safe distance from the lorries	L	
Children and adults on the float	Could fall from the float	M	Everyone must be seated at all times. Barrier around the edge of the float. Lorry driving slowly. Safety talk beforehand.	L
